RAGLAN EDUCATION FUND • Raglan Mine grants scholarships to Nunavik students who pursue postsecondary, college or university education preparing them for employment at Raglan Mine. Always highly motivated and committed to succeed, these students are known for the quality of their work and their academic results.

Am I Eligible?*

- In order to qualify, you must be an Inuit beneficiary within the meaning of the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement, and aspire to a career in an area linked with the activities of Raglan Mine.
- · If you pursue vocational training, the following conditions apply:
 - You must have successfully completed all your courses, with a minimum attendance rate of 80% at all classes.
 - You must stand in the top quartile (25%) of your study program.
- If you are a CEGEP or a university student, you must be registered on a full-time basis and maintain an overall minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 70%, B or 3.0.

When should I apply?

- Vocationnal Training Studies: Scholarship applicants can apply twice each year: by November 30th and by May 1st.
- CEGEP or University: Scholarship applicants can apply twice each year: by February 15th (Fall Semester) and by June 30th (Winter Semester).

- Attendance record (if applicable) of the last completed semester;
- Cover letter outlining your career goals at Raglan Mine;
- Letter of reference.
